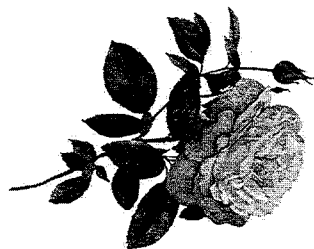
This **Adult Only** event is held on the Friday evening before Thanksgiving, and was formally called Noel Card Party.
