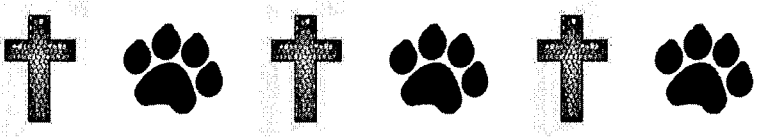

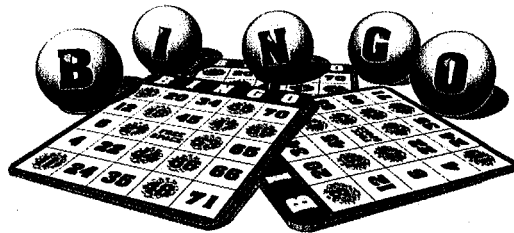

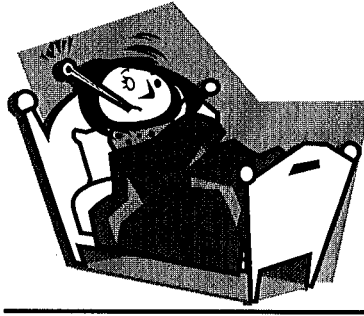

HEALTH ALERT!
1/18/2019

Just for your information: we have had several confirmed cases of Strep throat, as well as a few cases of stomach viruses in the past week. This time of year often brings an increase in the number of students out sick. Therefore, we are sending this note to help prevent the spread of illness by reminding everyone of our basic health policies.

Based on sound medical practice and healthcare standards, it is imperative that we comply with state guidelines in reference to ill students returning to school after their absence. Per page 42 of our student handbook, it mandates: **“Your child must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication (i.e. Tylenol/ Acetaminophen or Ibuprofen/Motrin) prior to your returning them to school. Please be aware, this timetable also applies to cases of stomach or intestinal disorders (Vomiting/Diarrhea)”**. To ignore this rule, needlessly puts other students at risk for illness. Please help keep our students in class and healthy by complying with this policy.

Additionally, if your child is treated for strep throat, please make sure that he/she is on antibiotics for a **minimum** of 24 hours before returning to school. Common symptoms of this infection may include a sore throat, headache, stomachache, and sometimes fever. Chicken pox and strep throat are reportable illnesses, so please notify the school office so that they may submit the required information to the local Health Department. Also, if your child is diagnosed with Influenza, please consider notifying the office so that we may adequately track and hopefully slow the spread of illness.

The best way to prevent the spread of illness is through the use of good hand washing. Please remind your child(ren) of its importance and have them practice it at home. Also, please remind you child(ren) to keep their hands away from their mouths and not to share drinks/food with other students.

DIOCESAN CELEBRATION OF THE WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

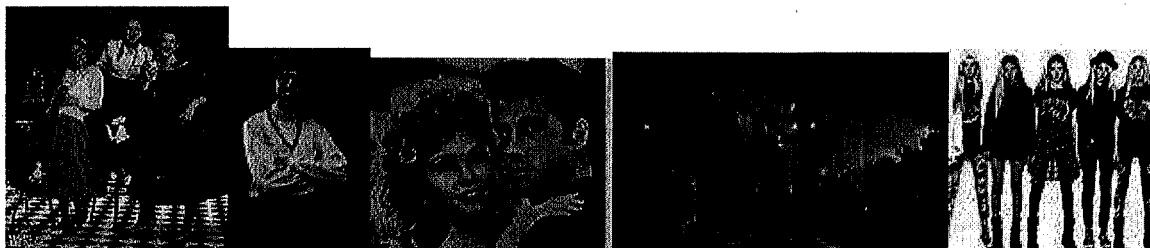

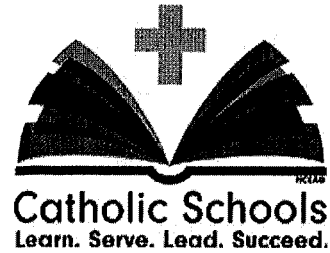
